II. Approval of Minutes

III. Financial Report

1. Grant Scurry reported via text. Balances as of February, 2017 are:

- b. Helping Hands \$968
- c. James Island Arts \$1,675

- 2. Our budget request has been set at \$3,500, the same as last year.
- 3. Purchases to be paid from this FY's budget need to be made by June.
- 4. Purchases over \$100 require committee approval.

- c. Grant is working on a map of the roads on the island so volunteers can be directed where needed.

- e. The Seaside Plantation HOA has decided to adopt Secessionville Road. MB will visit the next HOA meeting to answer questions.

2. Helping Hands
  - a. HOSA has agreed to volunteer for the April 22 Service Day.
  - b. Other groups are beginning to choose dates including some dates in the summer.
  - c. Kenneth Johnson is planning a carwash to benefit Helping Hands for a date to be chosen later.

  - b. Music was provided by High School, Middle School strings and Harbor View Elementary School
  - c. There are pieces of art remaining and could be sold
  - d. Final proceeds not yet finalized
  - e. Estimating that each teacher will receive a check for \$250 and \$25 gift cards from Artist and Craftsman for participation in the student art contest.

2. Amy Ball volunteered to set up an online list of our structure and areas of expertise.
3. Discussion of an Eagle Scout project in the works involving stickers advocating for care with oil that might go down drains. We may have some stickers we can distribute at the next litter pickup.
