On February 14th, 2018, the Folly Road Complete Streets Steering Committee will meet at the Town of James Island to discuss the implementation of the ReThink Folly Road plan from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm.

The Folly Road Complete Streets Plan (ReThink Folly Road) was created with robust citizen input and adopted by each member jurisdiction (Charleston, Charleston County, Folly Beach and James Island) in late 2015. In 2016 a memorandum of understanding was signed by each of the jurisdictions in an effort to ensure ongoing coordination communication, planning, and implementation of the numerous strategies recommended in the plan. These strategies seek to optimize mobility along the corridor through public improvements including, but not limited to, traffic signalization, enhanced bicycle and pedestrian facilities, opportunities to bury power lines, and enrich the overall aesthetics of the Folly Road Corridor between the Wappoo Cut and Folly Beach.
