

The Town of James Island held a Special Town Council meeting on Thursday, May 25, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, 1238-B Camp Road, James Island, SC. A quorum was present to conduct business. Also present: Ashley Kellahan, Town Administrator, Kristen Crane, Planning Director, Mark Johnson, Public Works Director, and Frances Simmons, Town Clerk,

Opening Exercises: Mayor Woolsey called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. FOIA: This meeting was published and posted in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act and the requirements of the Town of James Island.
