Whereas, the ground has already been cleared for the first "Gathering Place" on James Island; and

Whereas, property near the intersection of Folly and Grimball Road is zoned for a second Gathering Place; and

Whereas, these "Gathering Places" will greatly increase the amount of traffic and congestion on both the primary and secondary roads of James Island;

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Town of James Island wishes to share its concern regarding these developments in the City of Charleston and requests that it reconsider the utilization of this excessively dense zoning district on James Island.
