

RESOLUTION 2023-11

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE COMPOSITION OF EXISTING COMMITTEES OF TOWN COUNCIL AND CITIZEN COMMITTEES FOR THE TOWN OF JAMES ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, it is important that the Governing Board of the Town of James Island be organized to provide a forum for detailed analysis and exploration of Town wide issues and that Town citizens have an opportunity to provide community input and participate in service projects; and,

WHEREAS, over time, some issues may be resolved and new issues or areas of concern may require attention of new or revised compositions of the Committees of Council; and

WHEREAS, The Town of James Island recently elected a new Mayor and Councilmember who are able to provide an abundance of experience and expertise that may further the goals of the Committees of Council Staff have developed proposals and policies regarding the formation and implementation of committees of Town Council and citizen committees; and,

WHEREAS, at a special workshop of Council, the members reviewed and discussed these changes as detailed in “Exhibit A” and attached herein; and

WHEREAS, implementation of these modifications will assist the Town in delivering public services that are responsive to community goals and needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF JAMES ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA THAT:

Section 1. “Exhibit B” entitled “Committees of Council and Liaison Assignments” is hereby adopted and approved, with an expiration date of December 31, 2027, after the next municipal election, however, it may be revised after the 2025 election to add two new Councilmembers.

Section 2. This resolution to become effective upon its adoption and approval.


